

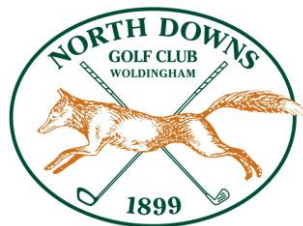

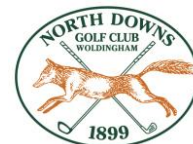
MEMBERSHIP APPLICANT'S PRIVACY NOTICE

- Your name will be available for use with the BRS online booking system.
- Your data will be retained for as long as you remain a member of the Club and will remain with England Golf unless you explicitly request removal.
- We do not make your information available to any other organisations.
- You may modify your own contact details at any time by contacting the Secretary.
- You may withdraw your consent at any time by contacting the Secretary and your contact details will be removed. This will obviously prevent other Members contacting you in future.

North Downs Golf Club is the trading name of Safegolf Limited – Terms and Conditions

1. North Downs Golf Club (hereby referred to as the “Club”) is a proprietary members club affiliated to England Golf and Surrey County Golf Union.
2. Acceptance of an application by the Club constitutes a contract of membership between the Club and the applicant(s) subject to these terms and conditions. Club membership is conditional upon the observance of these terms and conditions (and any local terms and conditions in force), which are applicable to club membership. The Club retains absolute discretion in accepting or rejecting any application for membership without prejudice or giving any reason for so doing.
3. The Club reserve the right to introduce, delete or amend categories of membership on an annual basis. Full details of each category of membership are set out in available club literature.
4. The Club shall fix the membership subscription. Fees will be paid annually in advance, unless otherwise specified. Should the member terminate his/her membership for whatever reason including but not limited to illness, absence, relocation or death, the subscription fee is non-refundable and non-transferable. Any changes to the subscription fee will be notified to members on an annual basis with a minimum of two weeks’ notice in writing. Membership may be renewed by payment to the Club of the appropriate annual subscription fee in force. The Club however reserve the right to refuse renewal of a membership without giving any reason for so doing. Where applicable, joining fees and subscription fees include VAT at the standard rate. Joining fees are non-refundable and must be paid in full at the commencement of membership. The Club may terminate without prior written notice the membership of any member who falls in arrears with monthly payments more than 30 days.
5. New members shall be accepted into the Club on completion of an application form and payment of the subscription fee and joining fee, if applicable, relevant to their category. The Club shall have the final decision in relation to the appointment of all new members. The membership shall become active upon payment of the appropriate entrance fee and annual subscription. All new members agree to be bound by the Rules and Regulations of the Golf Club and agree to attend a new member meeting when notified.
6. Members of the Club will be provided with a bar card and bag tag, which will remain the property of the Club and must be returned to the club on cessation or suspension of membership. A small charge may be levied should a replacement card or bag tag be lost for any reason. Entry to the premises and golf course may be denied in the absence of these forms of membership identity. Loss of these items should be reported immediately to club office. All members shall keep the Club up to date with any changes in personal details, including address, telephone numbers etc. All changes shall be provided in writing.
7. Members are entitled to use the facilities of the Club available under the relevant category of membership. The Club reserve the right to withdraw all or any part of such facilities on a temporary or permanent basis when such facilities are required to be closed for inclement weather, repair, maintenance, development, or alteration work. Members and their guests use all facilities at their own risk.
8. Playing times may vary depending on daylight hours. The first tee shall not be before 7:30am.
9. The Proprietor may at their discretion close the course for unavoidable maintenance for up to 10 days in each year.
10. Buggies and trolleys are permitted for use but may be banned from time to time in accordance with assessment of ground conditions and the guidelines set out by the Head Greenkeeper.
11. All golfers must check in before play and are advised to arrive at least ten minutes ahead of their start time. Whilst every effort will be made to accommodate late arrivals, it may not be possible to gain access to the course if times are unavailable.
12. The rules of the game of golf adapted from time to time by The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews shall apply to play at the Club. The Club shall set the standards of dress and etiquette for both the course and clubhouse. More details appear on the Club notice board for adherence to by all members and visitors.
13. The Club reserve the right to refuse admission or cancel membership immediately if any member shall in the opinion of the senior staff member on duty cause nuisance or annoyance to other club users or club staff. In the event of cancellation of membership, joining fees and subscriptions may not be refunded.
14. All members intending to resign their membership shall do so in writing, notifying the Club Office prior to membership renewal. Should a member return within two years there may do so without requiring payment of a second joining fee. No refund will be granted on subscription or joining fee.
15. Any member who is in material or persistent breach of the Club Rules and Regulations shall be liable to have all their rights of membership suspended by The Club for such time it considers appropriate. In the event of a continual breach of competition rules or inappropriate behaviour during Club Competitions or whilst representing the Club, the Club Committee may suspend any member for a period from these events, the Committee advising The Club of such action. Whilst suspended a member shall remain liable for payment of all dues. A suspended member shall be given the right of representation and an explanation prior to any imposed suspension.
16. The Club may expel any member whose conduct, is injurious to the character, goodwill or interests of the Club or renders the member unfit to be associated with members of the Club. If the Club Committee so requires in relation to any member, the Club shall investigate the behaviour, in conjunction with the club committee of any member and consider whether that member shall be expelled from the Club. The club committee must not act in anyway by themselves which might prejudice the company or cause it financial loss. An expelled member shall forfeit all rights of the membership category and a proportion of the remaining term of subscription shall be refunded. The joining fee paid will not be refunded.
17. Guests may be introduced by members of the club subject to the approval of club staff. Guests must be always accompanied by the member, be signed in and pay the appropriate guest fee. The member will assume responsibility for ensuring that guests abide by club rules and codes of behaviour.
18. Members may sign in up to three guests per day subject to payment of the appropriate green fee prior to the commencement of the round. A member whose guest plays without the payment of a green fee on the day shall be reprimanded and the guest shall be barred. Members guest rates shall be set by The Club and subject to change from time to time. Members may introduce guests to the Clubhouse facilities at no charge.
19. Except for guide dogs or hearing dogs for the deaf, pets must not be brought on to the golf course and into the Clubhouse.
20. All members and guests must enter the premises at the appropriate entrance point only. Members should make themselves aware of appropriate emergency exit points and procedures and be prepared to use these and follow staff instructions in the event of an emergency.
21. The Club cannot accept liability for members’ cars, the contents of vehicles or other property, which are bought to The Club at the member’s, own risk. The Club’s liability for damage or loss of members and guests’ property is strictly limited to any damage or loss caused directly because of the negligence of the Club, its staff, or agents. Any item of lost/found property unclaimed for a period greater than 2 months may be disposed of.
22. Any member or guest who suffers an accident on club premises or grounds must report the circumstances and details of the accident/incident to the senior staff member on duty immediately. The Club cannot accept any liability for any accident to a member or guest other than liability that may arise from the negligence of the Club.
23. The member is financially liable to the Club for annual membership fees and any goods and services used at the Club from time to time. The Club shall not be responsible for damage, injury or loss occurring because of an act or omission of any member or visitor to the Club. A member or visitor shall indemnify the Club against any such liability. Any member or visitor who makes use or accepts use of any facility or service at the Club shall do so at their own risk, provided that the Club is not proved negligent in its provision. The Club cannot be held responsible for any loss of play due to inclement weather conditions resulting in course closures.
24. The Club whose decision shall be final, and binding shall determine any dispute or difference, which may arise regarding interpretation of these rules. The Club reserves the right to amend the rules at any time, notifying such change on the club notice board. Individual notice to members will not be required.
25. Management of the Club and facilities is controlled by the Club who require members and guests to comply with any reasonable directions given to ensure the smooth operation of the Club.
